2020 Year in Review

2020 was a challenging and difficult, yet inspiring year. Inspiring is not a word you usually hear used to describe 2020, I use it because we have been so inspired by our grant partners. Many of you on the front lines of the pandemic have fought hunger, homelessness, illness, violence, and despair. It is our privilege to support, even in a small way, the amazing work done by so many dedicated people in 2020. To more effectively respond to the pandemic, the Board of Directors made an additional \$513,500 available to the funds already budgeted for 2020. Eighty four organizations received grants totaling \$1,312,000. The average grant award was \$11,231 with a range of \$1,000 to \$27,000 in awards. An additional \$100,000 was distributed as a legacy grant. \$366,500 supported 982 individuals through the emergency support fund to meet basic needs including housing, medical equipment, and transportation assistance. The Baby and Me Tobacco Free program, a statewide tobacco cessation service for pregnant women, adapted to the pandemic and developed new technology to reduce barriers for participation.



Total of \$1.88 Million Invested

Priority areas for funding are basic needs, behavioral health, physical, oral and visual health, and COVID response.

22 Western Colorado Counties

Thirteen board members, representing all parts of the Western Slope, oversee the activities of the foundation. Grants were made to serve people in all 22 counties.


