Grant Review Criteria 2023 - Healthcare Fund

REQUIRED - Is a 501(c)(3), a 509(a) or a governmental, tribal, school, or public entity, or has a fiscal 1 sponsor.

2 REQUIRED - Provides services and has staff residing on the Western Slope.

REQUIRED - Has a system for collecting and reporting demographic information for the ethnicity/race of the people served.

REQUIRED - The percentage of people served by the organization who identify as a person of color 4 is AT LEAST proportional to their county demographic for POC.

Services are strongly aligned with the purpose of the Healthcare fund: behavioral health (mental health counseling & therapy, including grief counseling; animal-assisted behavioral health

5 therapies; substance abuse intervention & recovery; suicide prevention; crisis response) physical health (medical, dental, vision or hearing screening & direct services; animal-assisted physical or occupational therapies; specialized disability services; health navigator/promotora; hospice/palliative/home health care; securing health insurance)

- 6 Has clear outcomes that demonstrates positive impact for the people served.
- 7 Has measurable indicators and tracks progress toward outcomes.
- 8 Regularly seeks input from participants and modifies services based on participant feedback.
- 9 Is aware of and works with other services in their area.
