

Grant Review Criteria Healthcare Fund

1 **REQUIRED - Is a 501(c)(3), a 509(a) or a governmental, tribal, school, or public entity, or has a fiscal sponsor.**

2 **REQUIRED - Provides services primarily to Western Slope residents and has staff residing on the Western Slope.**

Services are strongly aligned with the purpose of the Healthcare fund:

3 **behavioral health** (mental health counseling & therapy, including grief counseling; animal-assisted behavioral health therapies; substance abuse intervention & recovery; suicide prevention; crisis response)

physical health (medical, dental, vision or hearing screening & direct services; animal-assisted physical or occupational therapies; specialized disability services; health navigator/promotora; hospice/palliative/home health care; securing health insurance)

4 **Primarily serves a specific underserved, marginalized or vulnerable population.** (including but not limited to: Medicaid eligible; people living with physical, intellectual, and developmental disabilities; uninsured people; non-English speakers; LGBTQ+ people; migrant, immigrant & refugee communities; indigenous people)☐

5 **Has clear outcomes that demonstrates positive impact for the people served.**

6 **Has measurable indicators and tracks progress toward outcomes.**

7 **Regularly seeks input from participants and modifies services based on participant feedback.**

8 **Is aware of and works with other services in their area.**

Is fiscally stable:

Board reviewing financials on a regular basis

9 *Some reserves*

Outside fiscal review appropriate to budget size (compliance, review, audit)

Close to break-even annual budgets or good reason why not
